HADLEY'S DOG PARK RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

Member Rules:

- ◆ Dog Park membership is valid from when you register and continues until it expires, unless earlier terminated at the sole discretion of the Dubuque Regional Humane Society (DRHS).
- ◆ Membership fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- ◆ Dogs must be healthy, fully immunized, and dewormed. Vaccination records including Bordetella (Kennel Cough), Rabies, and Distemper (including parvovirus—must be a one or three year vaccine) must be current; owner must provide proof of vaccination records at time of registration.
- ◆ Only two dogs per adult (18 years or older).
- ◆ No toys are allowed in the park at any time.
- ◆ The DRHS has the right to amend Dog Park Rules and Requirements at any time without notification.

Owner/Guardian Requirements:

- ◆ Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by or to their dogs. Enter at your own risk.
- ◆ Remain with and watch your dog(s) at all times. Maintain voice control over your dog(s).
- ◆ It is not permitted at any time to leave your dog(s) unsupervised in the Dog Park. If you need to leave the Park, you must take your dog(s) with you. Abandoning animals is prohibited.
- ◆ Keep the leash on your person and readily accessible at all times while inside the Dog Park. This allows you to be able to act quickly if you need to suddenly remove your dog for safety purposes.
- ◆ Do not have your dog unleashed between your vehicle and the gated entrance.
- ◆ Clean up after your dog(s). Please use the dispensers and waste containers located within the Park. Please help by picking up orphan poops to keep the park clean and disease free.
- ◆ Children 12-17 years old must be accompanied by an adult; some dogs exhibit unpredictable behavior around small children. No children under the age of 12 are permitted in the Dog Park.
- ◆ No rawhide or food of any kind is allowed inside the Dog Park, including dog or human food. No smoking or alcohol is allowed in the Dog Park.
- ◆ To help keep the Dog Park clean, grooming is not allowed.
- ◆ Do not enter the double-gated transition area if there is already another dog in it. Gates must remain closed except upon entering and exiting.
- ◆ Do not let others without a pass into the Park. If this occurs, the DRHS has the right to revoke your membership without refund.

Dog Requirements

- ◆ Dogs with communicable diseases are not allowed on Park premises at any time.
- ◆ Puppies under four months old and female dogs in heat are prohibited.
- ◆ Aggressive dogs are not allowed in the Dog Park. Dogs exhibiting aggressive behavior are to be immediately removed from the Park. An aggressive dog is defined as any dog that is determined by the DRHS to pose a threat to dogs or people by virtue of a single incident or history of acts of aggression against people or animals. The DRHS has the right to refuse access to any dog.
- ◆ Digging is not permitted. Owners/guardians must fill in holes their dogs dig in the Park.
- ◆ Choke or prong collars are not permitted in the Park; they can snag on trees, fencing, or Park furniture as well as on another dog's mouth.
- ◆ Due to the zoonotic potential (humans acquiring) of intestinal parasites, a bi-annual stool sample check is recommended.
- ◆ Monthly use of a flea and tick product is recommended since fleas can survive in grass during warm climates, and ticks can transmit Lyme disease.

HADLEY'S DOG PARK HOURS AND REFUND POLICY

Operating Hours

The DRHS may and has the right to temporarily close the Dog Park for special events or shelter related activities. The Dog Park operating hours are 6:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m. year-round.

Refund Policy

All Dog Park memberships are non-refundable and non-transferrable. The key fob must be returned within 1 year of expiration to receive your deposit refund.

The undersigned, in consideration of the acceptance of this application and as a precedent to using the Dubuque Regional Humane Society Hadley's Dog Park and facilities, agrees to the fullest extent permitted by law to save, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Dubuque Regional Humane Society and its officers, agents, sponsors, employees, and volunteers from and against any and all claims, demands, suits, damages, or loss, including any and all outlay and expense connected therewith resulting from any bodily injury or property damage which arises out of or in connection with my and/or my animals and/or my children's use of the Dubuque Regional Humane Society Hadley's Dog Park and facilities.

I agree to waive, release, and discharge and covenant not to sue the Dubuque Regional Humane Society and its officers, employees, volunteers, sponsors, and agents from any and all liability to myself, my children, and/or my animals for any and all loss or damage and any claim or demands therefore, on account or injury to myself, my children, and/or my animals or other property arising out of or related to the use of the Dog Park. In addition, I am waiving my right to claim against the Dubuque Regional Humane Society and its officers, employees, volunteers, sponsors, and agents and am absolving them from any and all liability which may be based upon the acts, omissions, or negligence of Dubuque Regional Humane Society and its officers, employees, volunteers, sponsors, and agents.

By completing this document or any document provided by the Dubuque Regional Humane Society, I understand and agree to any and all rules, requirements, restrictions, or guidelines as contained herein or as may be posted or provided from time to time. I agree that if any part of this agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable that the remainder of this agreement shall be held in full force and effect. Furthermore, I acknowledge and agree that I have provided information herein accurate to the best of my knowledge. I hereby complete this information and execute it for myself, my children, my heirs, successors, and/or assigns. I also hereby attest that if I am not the sole owner of the animals subject to this application, that I have the full right and duty to execute this agreement on behalf of any owners or representatives of such animal.
